The Site Warden is crucial in maintaining a safe system of work when appointed by a Controller of Site Safety (COSS). This course covers the duties, roles and responsibilities of a Site Warden. This includes the procedures to be followed when acting as a Site Warden, the responsibilities of a Site Warden, the equipment required to be carried and the methods of warning required to be used.

Upon successful completion of the course:-

- Delegates Sentinel cards endorsed with SW
- Interim assessment will take place after 12 months.
- Delegates must have 4 logbook experiences recorded within the 12 months or the competence will be withdrawn
